Cleaning required by all teachers/staff/hirers at Colours of Dance during the Covid-19/other Pandemic

At Colours of Dance we take the health and well-being of our community very seriously. Our community includes Students, their parents/family members who wait in the building during classes, Faculty (teachers & pianists), Staff, volunteers and visitors. All users of the studios will be asked to make exactly the same medical declaration and to adhere to the Colours of Dance Covid-19 Health & Safety Plan & Procedures.

Entry to the building & studio

- 1. Staff must make a medical declaration to another member of staff (or review if by self) on entry to
- 2. During 3.30-6pm Colours of Dance will have a member of staff at the door to carry out entry/exit process. Outside these hours, teachers must greet pupils at the door and perform the medical declaration
- 3. All Students must make a medical declaration before entering the building
- 4. Staff/students/teachers should wash their hands on entry to the building/use hand sanitiser5. Outside shoes MUST be removed by anyone stepping into any studio
- 6. All windows in the studio should be opened if not already
- 7. The teacher may choose to mop the floor, wipe the barres and the electronic equipment if they wish to as part of their set up.
- 8. The teacher should wipe down the nearest toilet seat & lid with a disinfectant wipe before they leave the building.

At the start of each class

- 1. The teacher should ensure that each student is shown to their place in the studio where they can put their bag and remove street clothes or wait as needed
- 2. The teacher should remind pupils that if they need to use the bathroom during class they should wipe down the toilet seat & lid before washing their hands and returning to class
- 3. If masks become mandatory, teachers must ensure that this rule is observed. Masks are otherwise optional

At the end of each class

- 1. Once the students have left, the teacher should:
 - a. Clean the floor with the spray mop supplied if floor work has been undertaken
 - b. Clean the barres using the anti-bacterial wipes supplied
 - Close windows unless handing over to another teacher or continuing with another class

At the end of every day/hire session

- The teacher should perform the end of class cleaning as usual PLUS wipe down the nearest toilet/basin
- 2. The teacher should refill the spray mop tank if the level is at 50% or less3. The teacher should remove the mop cloth, rinse it out/remove hair or dust, and put into the cleaning fluid for microwaving
- 4. Staff should ensure the bathroom floors are mopped once a day
